

IMPORTANT NOTE*

The Assault Industries bezel is designed with very tight tolerences so that it will not pop off of the OEM guage. Removal is not possible without destroying it. Proper alignment is critical as once the Assault Industries bezel is applied, it will be very difficult to rotate or remove.

INSTALLATION

1. Wrap head of flathead screwdriver with cloth.

2. Place cloth-wrapped screwdriver head under the plastic OEM bezel and carefully pry it away from the dashboard.

3. *Align Assault Industries aluminum bezel (Fig. 1) so that it is centered properly over the OEM speedometer.

4. Press bezel firmly into place.

5. Admire your work.



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9. 10. CLERICAL ERRORS: Stenographical and clerical errors are subject to correction.

11. APPLICABILITY: This document and any subsequent Agreement referred to herein shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California, including the California Uniform Commercial Code. This Agreement shall binding upon the successors, assigns, affiliates and any other related third parties of Buyer.

12. SEVERABILITY: Invalidity of any of the terms provided herein shall not affect the validity of any other term.

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
